Previous Owners: J. W. Coon. From 1820 to 1840.

Mary B. Armstead. From 1887 to 1905. *Steele*

Date of Erection: 1820.

Architect: Unknown.

Builder: J. W. Coon.

Present Condition: Very good state of preservation.

Number of Stories: Two and one-half.

Materials of Construction: Brick house with sheet metal roof.

It has two interior chimneys. There is a two story porch which extends across the front with small box columns, the first floor of this porch is of concrete. The building consists of seven rooms, and two halls, the interior walls are plastered and papered. The floors are of 8" heart of pine flooring. There are two dormer windows on the front side of the roof. It has a wing which extends to the left rear.
