From 1932 to the present time.

Previous Owners: From 1840 to 1860, unknown.  
Pitt Clark: From 1860 to 1880.  
A Stock Co.: From 1880 to 1895  
A. P. Smith: From 1895 to 1932.

Date of Erection: 1840.

Architect: Unknown.

Builder: Unknown.

Present Condition: Good state of preservation. This structure was remodeled in 1895, by A. P. Smith, for a dwelling house, which was formerly used as a school. A room was added to the left rear to be used as a kitchen.

Number of Stories: Two.

Materials of Construction: Frame house with sheet metal gable roof, the foundation is of brick. The exterior walls are of 6" heart of pine weather-boarding, the interior walls are plastered, and papered. The floors are of 6" heart of pine flooring. The first floor front has one Colonial door, and two small doors, the second floor has one Colonial door. It has four fluted columns. The house consists of eight rooms, two halls, and two baths.
