Materials of Construction: Masonry foundation; the walls are of solid brick with a finish of stucco, which is marked off in rectangles of 15" by 44". At the present date the stucco has cracked and the brick shows through in a number of places. The interior walls are of plaster; the floors are of heart of yellow pine. There was originally a metal roof on the house, it is now covered with composition roofing.
