History: Built in early 1850's when an active community. Now Ghost Town. In existance until late 1930's when some Chinese miners bought the property, destroyed what was left of the building in order to sift the earth for gold.

Description: One-story wood frame false front building, with chammel rustic siding on front and board and batton side walls. Marquise at front supported by wood posts with shingle roof.
