History: Built in 1845 on 1500 acre ranch given Don Fernando by his father Don Salvio Pacheco, who had been given a grant to 17,922 acre Rancho Monte del Diablo in 1834-1835 by Mexico when he was a captain in Mexican army. Contra Costa County Horsemen Association helped restore adobe in 1940 and has occupied it as headquarters. Now deeded to County by Calif. Water Serv. Co.

Description: One-story and loft adobe with shed roof veranda supported by eight wood posts. Clapboard siding at gable ends. Underwent some alterations with restoration.
