History: Military post established in 1852 to protect miners from marauding Indians and named for Major Albert S. Miller Evacuated in 1856 and re-activated in 1863 during Civil War, but finally abandoned in 1864.

Description: Wagon crossing of wood construction with truss over deep channel. Protecting dam and trap for flotsam of timber construction upstream from ford.
