History: James Stuart Cain arrived at Bodie in 1879 at age of 25 and entered lumber business. With savings entered transportation business and then mining and banking. Acquired Standard Mine as a result of lawsuit and finally became principal owner of property in Bodie, now a deserted Ghost Town. In 1962 property acquired from J. S. Cain Co. as part of a State Park. House originally built by a Mr. McGrath and moved to present site, ca.1904,
