Casa Gutierrez (CAL-1201)

History: Built in 1851. Don Joaquin Gutierrez was Governor of Alta California for three months in 1836 and built two two-story adobes on Main Street.

Description: Two-story adobe street-front building with lean-to at rear. Adobe plaster at street front and covered with rustic siding at gable end. 12-light DH

(Over)

windows with louvered shutters. Entrance at center flanked by one window at either side and second story windows directly over first story openings. State Landmark #713.
