REPRESENTED IN NEGATIVE FILE	H.A.B.S. SURVEY NO. CAL-166	<p><u>History:</u> Built in 1840-42 by Irwin Kellogg. Dr. Bale, English surgeon, arrived at Monterey in 1837. Became surgeon for California military under Gen. Mariano Vallejo. Became naturalized Mexican in 1841 and married Maria Ignacio Soberanes, niece of Gen. Vallejo. Granted Rancho Carne Humana, 4 leagues in 1841. Widow of W. W. Lyman, owner for many years gave Grist Mill to N.S.G.W. who restored it under leadership of P.G. Pres. Bismark Bruch a grandson of Dr. Bale.</p>

Description: Three story wood frame and timber building with false front capped with bracketted cornice. Huge wooden water sheel on north side is taller than building.
