History: Nevada County established in 1851 with Nevada City as County Seat. Center of rich quartz mining region.

Description: Three-story rectangular stone masonry building with parapet at roof. Ground story with rusticated arched portico. Second story Corinthian pilasters and square window heads.

Third story with arched windows and quoins at corners. Composition of entrance element is three stories high with arched portico projecting at ground floor forming balcony at second floor with one large arched opening and three arched openings at third story terminating with pediment at roof cornice. Granite front has been removed and architecture of building has been completely altered.
