EXTERIOR FEATURES OF NOTE Parapet largely stripped of detail and concealed behind plaster, upper-floor, one-over-one-light double-hung windows had flat cornice heads on consoles, three wrought-iron balconies on side facade, one on center of front facade, ground floor much altered, only caps of pilasters remain visible through the plaster.		
INTERIOR FEATURES OF NOTE (DESCRIBE FLOOR PLANS, IF NOT SKETCHED)		
MAJOR ALTERATIONS AND ADDITIONS WITH DATES Sold to J. McNulty in 1860 and to D. Ogden Mills & Co. Bank in 1865, remodeled thereafter; restored 1970s as part of Old Sacramento State Historic Park.
