History: The present view comes
from Sarony and Major's litho-PUBLISHED
PHOTOGRAPHSgraph (1856). Named for James Cunningham.
It was often called the "T" wharf because of
its shape, which accommodated six vessels.
Moored at the eastern side are the Senator
and the New World, famous river steam boats
