de Anza. Taken over by U. S. Army in 1846
as an Officers' Club. Revised ca. 1880 with
a new central section and square end bays.PUBLISHED
DRAWINGS"Restored" 1933 to a pseudo-Hispanic appear-
ance, with tile roof, low extended porch,
etc. Interior revamped entirely.

Description: Early structure of adobe with earthen floor and paneless windows. Victorian revisions in wood with brackets and Stick period detail. 1933 "restoration" in adobe, wood and tile. Building faced north to an open plaza with other structures around.
