

SIGNIFICANCE (ARCHITECTURAL AND HISTORICAL, INCLUDE ORIGINAL USE OF STRUCTURE) Significant as a typical millworker tenement - it has the characteristic multiple-entry, symmetric facade, and clapboarded exterior - and for its associations with Putnam Mfg. Co., one of Putnam's important textile manufacturers in the period 1865-1925.			
STYLE (IF APPROPRIATE) Vernacular			
MATERIAL OF CONSTRUCTION (INCLUDE STRUCTURAL SYSTEMS) Wood-frame construction, clapboarded exterior, central brick chimney, brick foundation (partly stuccoed), asphalt-shingled roof.			
SHAPE AND DIMENSIONS OF STRUCTURE (SKETCHED FLOOR PLANS ON SEPARATE PAGES ARE ACCEPTABLE) Two stories, shallow-pitched gable roof, ridge parallel to street. Basement full-story at rear. Rectangular plan, 41.5' x 24.7'.			
EXTERIOR FEATURES OF NOTE Facade has entrances at ends and six windows in between. Six-over-six old sash, plain frames. Wide overhanging eaves, boxed cornice. Right front entry has original four-panel door, as does central rear entry.			
INTERIOR FEATURES OF NOTE (DESCRIBE FLOOR PLANS, IF NOT SKETCHED) Modern ceilings, paneling, linoleum and/or narrow-board floors. Stairhalls and front rooms have narrow-board beaded wainscot. No posts or beams visible. One grain-painted door.			
MAJOR ALTERATIONS AND ADDITIONS WITH DATES			
PRESENT CONDITION AND USE Partly vacant and partly apartments; to be demolished for redevelopment. Basement unit condemned.
