



Although the building proportions and relationship to the historically significant building create architectural interest, the building has no historical significance. There is evidence that the building was constructed in two segments - which has contributed to its structural deterioration

MAJOR ALTERATIONS AND ADDITIONS WITH DATES Second level of poured concrete supported by steel columns					
PRESENT CONDITION AND USE The building is presently unused and engineering reports indicate structural deterioration extensive enough to render the building unsafe.
