Location: Orlando, Orange County, Florida

Significance: This house represents the dwindling historic fabric of the early, single- and multi-family Frame Vernacular dwellings that were constructed in the Holden-Parramore neighborhood of Orlando, Florida. This house was selected for documentation as part of the Interstate-4 Memorandum of Agreement.

Description: Located on the southwest corner of West Randall Street and South Lee Avenue, this one-story Frame Vernacular residence exhibits Craftsman style elements. The building is clad in drop siding and rests on a concrete block pier foundation. This rectangular residence has an asymmetrical three-bay front façade and is covered with a front-gabled roof that is surfaced with sheet metal. A brick chimney is located in the eastern slope of the roof towards the rear of the house. A half-width front-gabled porch is situated on the north (front) façade, while a shed-roof porch is located on the south (rear) façade. The house is ornamented with decorative wood brackets in the gable eaves, exposed rafter tails, wood door and window surrounds, cornerboards, and vertical wood vents in the gable eaves.

History: This house was constructed ca. 1935 in an area that was once the segregated African-American section of Orlando. Sanborn Insurance Maps show that this building was one of three wood frame dwellings located on the same lot facing West Randall Street. This house most likely represents a median income single-family residence that was typical of the neighborhood.


