Four and one-half miles from Milledgeville on the Old Eatonton Road. Date of construction uncertain, but prior to 1830. Probably designed by Daniel Pratt. First known owner: Col. Ben Jordon. Present owner(1936): Dr. L. E. Lindsley.

Two-story, frame construction, pitch roof, two-story pedimented Doric tetrastyle (paired columns) portico. Elaborate triglyph frieze on each facade and pediment. Banquet hall added in 1852.
