

Georgia. Frame, two story and attic. Early Republic.
No record available of the designer or
builder. The present owner and occupant, Dr. W. H.
Reynolds, has data stating that this house was occu-
pied and added to by Governor George Rockingham Gilmer,
who moved into the house in 1833.

Governor Gilmer died in this home in 1859.
