Materials of Construction: Foundation mostly stone covered with stucco; brick under corner buttresses. Construction above foundations wood throughout. Composition shingle roof.

Additional Data: Woodwork of interior said to be elaborately carved. Pews and chancel walnut. Gravestone at back on axis with church contains inscription: - Ella Beth Margarita White 1819-1850.

Mrs. Greer Maxwell of Talbotton writes: - "Used regularly on fifth Sabbath in each month. A mission served by Rev. Mr. Wilson of LaGrange and Bishop Mikell of Atlanta. A gallery on two sides extending east and west. Choir loft over vestibule containing a very old pipe organ pumped by hand. Organ used at every service. Lighted by candles held in a six branched candelabra."
