STAGE COACH INN (THE BRYAN PLACE)
Marshallville, (vicinity) Macon County, Georgia

Owner: John Murph.

Date Erected: Approximately 1810.

Present Condition: Delapidated.

Number of Stories: Center portion of house two stories.
Front and back lean-tos one-story.

Materials of Construction: Foundation rubble piers without mortar, frame construction throughout; hand hewn girders, sills and beams mortised and tennoned under floors, original hand cut boarding in interior floors, walls and ceilings; no plaster.

Additional Data: Unpainted wood throughout. This is of the familiar "Dog Trot" type, the central portion being open through from front to back. Nathan Bryan built this house in 1810 at side of old highway and it was used as an inn for many years. It is now a mile or so from the present highway in a secluded spot.
