LEE HOUSE

Location:

The Lee House is located at 19 Henrietta Street in Savannah, Chatham County, Georgia. This address is in the southwest quadrant of Henrietta and Richardson Streets in the Wagner Heights neighborhood.

Significance:

The Lee House is historically significant in the areas of architecture and community development. Architecturally, it is an example of a front gabled bungalow with Craftsman features. It also contributes to an understanding of early twentieth century urban development due to its role in the Wagner Heights neighborhood.

Description:

This one story, rectangular frame bungalow has a gabled principal roof with exposed rafters, and a hipped attached porch supported by battered wood piers on brick pedestals. The house retains its original clapboard siding, paired windows and irregular floor plan. Interior features include mirrored mantels, French doors, wood floors and plaster walls. At the time of the photographs, the mantels and doors had been removed.

History:

This residence was built c. 1925.



