Significance: The U.S. Naval Base at Pearl Harbor was designated as a National Historic Landmark in 1964. As a Category 3 facility, it has been determined that Building No. 429 functioned as part of the Pearl Harbor Naval Base, but is only of minor importance to the historic character of the National Historic Landmark.


Description: Building No. 429 is a permanent two-story concrete structure located at Jarvis Street and Kuahua Avenue. The area of the building is approximately 5,100 square feet.

History: Building No. 429 was constructed in 1921 as a storehouse and bag sewing building. The first floor was used for storage and the second floor was used as bag sewing room. The building is currently used as a shop for the Navy divers. Plans for demolition of the existing building are included in Military Construction (MCON) Project P-115, which proposes to demolish the existing building and construct a new Intermediate Maintenance Activity (IMA) Facility.


