Significance:

The U.S. Naval Base at Pearl Harbor was designated as a National Historic Landmark in 1964. As a Category 3 structure, it has been determined that Building No. 310 functioned as part of the Pearl Harbor Naval Base, but is only of minor importance to the historic character of the National Historic Landmark.

Description:

Building No. 310 is a single-story wood/concrete masonry structure with wood frame and corrugated metal roof. The approximate area of Building No. 310 is 5420 square feet.

History:

Building No. 310 was constructed in 1942 to serve as an Open Enlisted Mess Hall/Snack Bar at a cost of \$175,315. Building No. 310 is a semi-permanent structure considered inadequate due to its deteriorated state and its location within the explosive arcs of the Whiskey Wharves at the West Loch Branch of Naval Magazine, Lualualei. Building No. 612 has replaced Building No. 310 as an Open Enlisted Mess/CMO Club. A portion of Building No. 310 is being used temporarily as an office/administrative space for the CMO Club. The remainder of the building is unoccupied.
