
Significance: The U.S. Naval Base at Pearl Harbor was designated as a National Historic Landmark in 1964. As a Category 3 structure, it has been determined that Building No. 1200 functioned as part of the Pearl Harbor Naval Base, but is only of minor importance to the historic character of the National Historic Landmark.

Description: Building No. 1200 consists of a single-story wooden structure with built-up roofing, approximately 31 feet wide by 36 feet in length. The building also has an adjacent wood framed carport with corrugated metal roofing, with an approximate area of 500 square feet.

History: Building No. 1200 was constructed in 1942 to serve as a Pilot Boathouse at a cost of \$13,646. The existing building is deteriorated with extensive termite damage. Plans for demolition of Building No. 1200 are included in Military Construction (MCON) Project P-117, which proposes to demolish the existing building in support of constructing a new submarine berthing wharf. A new Pilot Boathouse will be constructed at Hospital Point, Pearl Harbor Naval Shipyard.
