- IN-92-01    LOOKING SOUTHEAST, A VIEW OF THE BRIDGE TAKEN FROM THE NORTH WEST SHOWING THE NORTHERN SIDE AND TWO OF THE THREE ARCHES.
- IN-92-02    LOOKING SOUTHEAST FROM THE WEST BANK OF HAW CREEK. A CLOSE-UP PHOTO OF THE NORTH SIDE OF THE BRIDGE, ITS PARAPETS AND THE UTILITY PIPES SUSPENDED FROM ITS OVERHANG.
- IN-92-03    A LONG VIEW OF THE STRUCTURE, LOOKING NORTH EAST, TAKEN FROM THE SOUTHWEST BANK, SHOWING THE SOUTHERN SIDE OF THE BRIDGE.
- IN-92-04    LOOKING NORTHEAST, A MEDIUM CLOSE-UP IMAGE OF THE SEVENTH STREET BRIDGE TAKEN FROM THE SOUTHWEST, SHOWING THE PARAPET, A PIER AND THE SANITARY SEWER LINE SUSPENDED FROM THE OVERHANG.
- IN-92-05    A PHOTOGRAPH TAKEN FROM THE ROADWAY OF THE BRIDGE, LOOKING SOUTH (DOWNSTREAM), ALONG HAW CREEK.
- IN-92-06    AN IMAGE OF THE PORTAL, ROADWAY, SIDEWALKS AND PARAPET OF THE BRIDGE, LOOKING WEST FROM THE EASTERN APPROACH.
- IN-92-07    A PHOTOGRAPH OF HAW CREEK TAKEN FROM THE BRIDGE ROADWAY, LOOKING NORTH. HAW CREEK BOULEVARD IS AT THE LEFT.
- IN-92-08    LOOKING NORTH FROM THE SOUTH BANK, A DETAIL IMAGE OF THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF THE BRIDGE.

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- IN-92-09 A PHOTO OF THE UNDERSIDE OF THE STRUCTURE, TAKEN FROM THE SOUTHWEST, LOOKING NORTHEAST. VISIBLE ARE SPALLED PIERS AND STARLINGS, SEWER AND WATER PIPES, THE SIDEWALK BRACKETS AND A HIGHWATER GAUGE PAINTED ON THE WESTERNMOST PIER.
- IN-92-10 LOOKING NORTH, A DETAIL IMAGE OF A PIER ON THE SOUTH SIDE OF THE BRIDGE, TAKEN FROM THE SOUTH.
- IN-92-11 A PHOTOGRAPH LOOKING DUE EAST, TAKEN FROM THE SAND BAR, SHOWING THE EASTERNMOST PIER AND A PORTION OF THE ENTRADOS OF A CONCRETE ARCH. PATTERNS IN THE CONCRETE REVEAL THAT THE WOOD-FORMED ARCH WAS POURED FIRST ON THE NORTH SIDE AND LATER ON THE SOUTH (OR VICE VERSA.) A CRACK HAS DEVELOPED ALONG THE COLD SET LINE.
- IN-92-12 A DETAIL VIEW OF THE UNDERSIDE OF THE MIDDLE ARCH, LOOKING SOUTHEAST. CONCRETE PARGED PATCH AND REINFORCING BARS ARE VISIBLE AS WELL AS PATTERNS FROM THE WOOD FORM.
- IN-92-13 LOOKING NORTH FROM THE SOUTH, A DETAIL IMAGE OF THE BRONZE DEDICATION PLAQUE, LOCATED ON THE NORTH INSIDE PARAPET. A TWIN PLAQUE ON THE SOUTHWEST PARAPET.
- IN-92-14 LOOKING NORTH FROM THE SOUTHEAST BANK. THIS PHOTO DETAIL SHOWS THE MEMORIAL DEDICATION TO THE WORKER, V.S. MARLIN, WHO DIED IN A FALL WHILE WORKING ON THE 1928 RENOVATION OF THE BRIDGE.
- IN-92-15 LOOKING NORTH, FROM THE ROADWAY, A VIEW OF THE INSIDE OF THE NORTH SIDE OF THE BRIDGE. THE WORDS "HAW CREEK" ARE CAST IN THE CENTER PANEL OF THE PIER AT THE CENTER OF THE PHOTOGRAPH.

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
