IN-289A-01 View looking northwest of the south facade of the building showing the narrow clapboard siding and roof monitors.

IN-289A-02 View looking southwest from the northern portion of the lawn surrounding Building 27. The north opening is visible, and one on the east side, as well as the remains of a piperail and canvas covering over the stairway, south of the window.

IN-289A-03 Image looking west. Medium close up of the east side, showing lower door opening.

IN-289A-04 View looking northeast toward the east side of the building, showing the original brick wall and wood siding of the addition, as well as the concrete foundation.

IN-289A-05 Medium close up view looking northeast showing the running bond and west opening.

IN-289A-06 Close up view looking southeast, of the north side of the building.

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elsewhere on the fort, or an alternate plan for the building which was never constructed. (8"x10" print enlarged from 4" x5" negative.)

IN-289A-09 Print of a drawing: "Proposed Central Heating Plant. Quartermaster Area. Fort Benjamin Harrison. Indiana." 7S1, Plan No. 1, dated January 8, 1920. (8"x10" print enlarged from 4" x5" negative.)
