



- Location: The West Tool Shed is located at 2012 W. Illinois Ave., north of the Spangerberger Farmstead residence, northeast of the claim house and chicken house, and west of the east tool shed, South Hutchinson Vicinity, Reno County, Kansas.
- Present Owners: Kansas Department of Transportation
- Present Occupant: None
- Present Use: Vacant Outbuilding
- Significance: The west tool shed contributes to the historic character of the George Spangerberger Farmstead.
- Description: Two small tool sheds are located 63' north of the main residence and approximately 29' northeast of the claim house. Both small storage units have a southern orientation. They are situated approximately 4'-6" apart in the same line. Both were constructed ca. 1940.
- The George Spangerberger Farmstead west tool shed is the smaller of the two storage units, measuring approximately 6' x 8'. This rectangular building has an asphalt shingled, gable roof and plywood-clad exterior walls. The tool shed has a board floor and is supported slightly above grade by several partially buried concrete blocks. The gable end has a Z-brace vertical board door, and a wood drip board over the door. A louver vent is centered in the gable above the doorway. There are no additional doors or windows in this structure.
- The West Tool Shed is in good condition.




SITE PLAN SHOWING THE LOCATION OF THE
