





MATERIAL OF CONSTRUCTION (INCLUDE STRUCTURAL SYSTEMS) Brick Common bond masonry walls resting on a cut stone foundation; rear section wood frame covered in sawn weatherboard on a cinder block foundation; wood joists and floors; asphalt roofing material

EXTERIOR FEATURES OF NOTE Front facade gable decorated with diamond paned shingling and denticulated cornice; main entrance element with segmented transom capped by a denticulated cornice.

MAJOR ALTERATIONS AND ADDITIONS WITH DATES Two-stage rear shed addition constructed during the 20th century		
PRESENT CONDITION AND USE The building is in poor condition but structure is abandoned		
OTHER INFORMATION AS APPROPRIATE The building is in the East Main Street Redevelopment Area and due to its condition, it will probably be razed. During the archaeological reconnaissance conducted for the project a mid-19th century pottery kiln was documented to the rear of this structure.
