EXTERIOR FEATURES OF NOTE Projecting bay window, first floor, main floor; one-story porch supported by wood columns and cement block; overhanging cornice with deep soffit		
INTERIOR FEATURES OF NOTE (DESCRIBE FLOOR PLANS, IF NOT SKETCHED) Mahogany stained, pine staircase with paneled understair; tin ceiling in kitchen; cast iron mantle in second floor bedroom; door, window and baseboard trim is dark stained pine in a simple undecorated form.		
MAJOR ALTERATIONS AND ADDITIONS WITH DATES Rear one-story brick garage structure was built between 1912 and 1925		
PRESENT CONDITION AND USE Good condition but empty at present		
OTHER INFORMATION AS APPROPRIATE The structure is within the Frankfort East Main Street Redevelopment Project Area. It may be rehabilitated or razed.
