

SIGNIFICANCE (ARCHITECTURAL AND HISTORICAL, INCLUDE ORIGINAL USE OF STRUCTURE) The structure is a two and one-half story inverted "T" plan cross gable building with three apartments. Although it is of minor architectural significance as an individual building, it does contribute to the overall character of the area.		
STYLE (IF APPROPRIATE)		
MATERIAL OF CONSTRUCTION (INCLUDE STRUCTURAL SYSTEMS) Flat rake board construction with asbestos shingles.		
SHAPE AND DIMENSIONS OF STRUCTURE (SKETCHED FLOOR PLANS ON SEPARATE PAGES ARE ACCEPTABLE) Two and one-half inverted "T" plan cross gable structure with the front elevation enclosed by a two story four bay wide porch.		
EXTERIOR FEATURES OF NOTE The pediment has a molded cornice, and the front entrance has a flat five light transom and sidelights with leaded glass, and a glass and three panel oak door. The deep frieze and projecting eaves of the porch cornice continue along the side walls of the structure.		
INTERIOR FEATURES OF NOTE (DESCRIBE FLOOR PLANS, IF NOT SKETCHED) The interior was altered substantially.		
MAJOR ALTERATIONS AND ADDITIONS WITH DATES 1) No date, alteration by the application of modern wall board panelling. Most of the original oak accentuation has been removed or painted, and a concrete block garage was added to the rear. Enclosed two story porch built on front facade.		
PRESENT CONDITION AND USE Good, habitable residence owned and lived in by Mr. Charles R. Krause.





MAP OF FROSTBURG, JULY, 1930




FIRST FLOOR
