Significance:

Erected in 1930, this became one of four contributing warehouses located in the northeast section of the YARD.

Description:

Warehouse #41 was a one story 5:12 slope gabled, steel truss framed structure covered with uninsulated light gage steel siding and roofing. The building was anchored to a 2'-8" high concrete dock foundation, and measured 40' wide x 112' long x 10' high at the eaves. On the east side were four 9'-8" wide x 9' high double swing-out steel doors, spaced apart evenly. One similar door was centered in the north and south end. The siding was trapezoidal corrugated with three rows of two corrugations each 1/2" deep in a 2' wide panel, referred to as "Canadian Style." The panel joints were covered with a small batten. The roof panel was the same style but the corrugations were 1-1/2" deep and interlocked at the seam. Seven vents with conical caps were located on the ridge of the roof. The roof also had numerous skylights some of which were later covered with metal. Draft curtains of corrugated metal subdivided the building into 4 sections. There is evidence that partitions once were located below the draft curtains.

History:

No drawings or designer was recorded. This appears to have been an early pre-engineered steel structure. Early use was as a boat shed and unspecified storage. During WWII building was listed as "storage shed-survey public property". Bldg. #41 was listed on the National Register as a contributing resource-1981.


