Jacob Coonce came West from Pennsylvania and settled in St. Charles County in the year 1797. He married a Miss Rebecca McConnell.

This house, located one-half mile East of Weldon Springs, Mo., St. Charles County, was one of the first log cabins in this section of the country and was built in 1808.

This is a one story log cabin, frame covered with outside chimney.
