
This is a one story brick building,

The main façade, or street front, consists of six paneled brick pilasters, three of which are on each side of an enormous doorway design extending through the height of the vestibule and two balconies over it. This doorway and its frame are of wood, the real entrance doorway being a part of the lower panels. The main cornice above the brick pilasters and the pediment are of wood.

At the present time, the building is flanked on both sides with buildings, leaving only the main entrance façade visible from the street. The square brick tower at the rear of the structure is visible only from the courtyard.
