"Bogy's House"

This house located in Ste. Genevieve, Mo., was built before 1800 by John Bogy.

Mr. John Bogy was at one time Probate Court Judge and holder of several political offices in Ste. Genevieve County.

John Bogy was the father of Lewis V. Bogy, who was elected to the U.S. Senate from the State of Missouri. He took office in March 1873 and served until 1879.

This house was originally a log house built of cedar and oak, later it was reconstructed - spoiled by modernization and now lacks any architectural interest.

The property is now owned by Leonard Glaser.
