The Piaget-van Ravenswaay Survey consists of a number of photographs, primarily of sites and structures in Missouri, which were taken before 1938 by Alexander Piaget and after that by Paul Piaget, both in conjunction with Charles van Ravenswaay. Photographs of buildings were incorporated into the HABS collection in 1985 by Laura Rupp, HABS historian. A master list is available in the records for MO-1800.

These photographs, taken in the 1930s and 1940s, had facsimile negatives made in 1985 because of the non-archival condition of the original nitrate and di-acetate base negatives. Unless otherwise noted, the HABS reference photoprint is a contact print from the facsimile negatives.

In cases where no original negative survived, a copy negative was made from an original print. Copy negatives have been noted as such. In these cases, the HABS reference photoprint is a contact print from the copy negative.
