Description:

Brick; one story below (formerly) a hipped roof. Entrance at west in center door; no windows this elevation. Center door in south side flanked by two windows on each side. East wall has large Palladian opening with half-round center arch and flat arched flanking windows. Five windows in north wall, all segmental arched as in south wall.

Additional data:

This was at one time the Chapel Royal of the Province. Governors Dobbs and Tryon attended here.
