Date of erection: Mid-nineteenth century

Present condition: Good

Description:

Brick and frame; three stories toward Main Street; two stories, side streets and rear. Main Street facade 13 bays; two-bay end projecting pavilions; three-bay central portico; full-height Corinthian columns; subsidiary cast-iron galleries, first and second floors, between end pavilions; secondary portico three bays, Corinthian, on end elevation.

Additional data:

Built as combination dwelling and shop by nineteenth-century ironmaster. After the death of the last of the family the house was arranged for the accommodation of spinsters and widows, who occupy small apartments at nominal rentals. This places the maintenance of the house on a self-perpetuating basis.
