THE OLD HOTEL  
Murfreesboro, Hertford County, North Carolina

Owner: Charles Boyette

Date of erection: Probably early nineteenth century; enlarged c. 1850

Present condition: Good

Description:

The north front is covered by a two-story porch with wood columns of semi-Doric style. At the second-floor line these support a gallery. The house is two stories high with flat gable roof which extends over the porch. At the west end the whole is formed into a broad pediment, but the east end is informally treated. On the facade both house and porch are six bays long, two entrance doors occurring next to the end bays. The four other bays contain triple-mullioned windows; 6/6 lights in the center opening, 2/2 in the side openings.

Additional data:

Originally used as the hotel but later altered for dwelling purposes and now used as an apartment house.
