large arched transom from which leading has been removed. Above is door with similar sidelights leading to balcony supported on wrought-iron brackets. Interior has excellent trim of period but is characteristically plain. At right are pair of parlors divided by large arched opening with square paneled doors. Square type of paneling repeats in typical doors of house. Stair ascends in rear of hall and has continuous stair rail without posts.

History: House built by Skinner family and remains in their possession.
