## DAVIS HOUSE

New Hope vicinity, Perquimans County, North Carolina

Date of erection: Early eighteenth century, with later additions

Present condition: Fair

Description:

Frame; story and a half; brick end Flemish bond, vertical joints in gable line with rake of roof forming chevron pattern; projecting end chimney with weatherings; gable roof, modern dormers replacing old. Front four bays, 9/6-light sash. Front wall covered with flush horizontal sheathing. Shed porch front and one side, modern replacing old. Rear roof raised by shed frame extension.

Plan: center hall, stair ascending from rear extension. Stair old with turned balusters. All other trim apparently new.
