This little building, the architect or builder of which is unknown, was constructed about 1812 for Judge Donald, an Irish immigrant. It adjoins the brick mansion which was his home and from this office he conducted the extensive law practice which was his until his death. This structure was owned by the Donald family until about 1912, when the house and office were purchased by Mr. Frank W. Hughes, the present owner.

There have been no alterations or additions to the law office, and it is rapidly disintegrating from disuse.
