General Elias W. Leavenworth built his home in 1842. General Leavenworth was the second mayor of Syracuse. He became Secretary of State in 1853 and a member of Congress in 1874.

General Leavenworth married Mary Forman, a daughter of Joshua Forman, also a prominent Syracusan..

The Leavenworth house is now owned by Dr. and Mrs. Van Duyne. Mrs. Van Duyne is the granddaughter of General Leavenworth.
