Present Condition: Structurally good.

Number of Stories: Main house, two. Frame wing, one and one-half.

Materials of Construction: Brick walls, wood trim. Frame addition and barn. Metal roof.

Other Existing Records: Munsell's "History of Albany and Schenectady Counties", pages 214 and 215.

Additional Data: This house is situated on land which has been in the Schermerhorn family for eight generations. It is a brick building of modern construction, but with many features of an earlier period. The builder of this house was a man who held many positions in the county and lastly was Congressman for a number of terms.
