- NY-300-H-1 INTERIOR OF SHT (ROTARY DRYER FOR SODA) BUILDING OR DRYSIDE DRYERS WHICH REMOVED TRACES OF LIQUID FROM STD FILTRATE. HEAT CONVERTED SODIUM BICARBONATE TO SODIUM CARBONATE OR SODA ASH, THE PRINCIPAL PRODUCT OF THE WORKS.
- NY-300-H-2 INTERIOR OF SHT BUILDING OF DRYSIDE AFTER DEMOLITION HAS BEGUN. IT APPEARS THAT THE ROOF HAS BEEN REMOVED.
- NY-300-H-3 INTERIOR OF SHT BUILDING OF DRYSIDE AFTER DEMOLITION HAS BEGUN. FLOOR LEVEL SHOWING THE END OF A DRYER.
- NY-300-H-4 INTERIOR VIEW AFTER THE DEMOLITION HAS BEGUN. FLOOR LEVEL SHOWING A CLOSE-UP VIEW OF THE END OF A DRYER.
