**Significance:** Building No. 2307 served as a clothing store for enlisted personnel and featured replacement uniform clothing.

**Project Information:** Building No. 2307 at Plattsburgh Air Force Base (AFB) is being documented in accordance with HAER standards to mitigate for the potential adverse effects of transferring deed of title to the property from federal ownership. The property transfer is a result of the disposal and reuse of Plattsburgh AFB, pursuant to the Defense Base Closure and Realignment Act of 1993. The mitigation is a stipulation of a Programmatic Agreement (PA) among the U.S. Air Force, the New York State Historic Preservation Officer, and the Advisory Council on Historic Preservation (October 2000).

**Summary Description of Clothing Store (Building No. 2307)**

**Layout**

Building No. 2307 is a 3,052 square-foot, one-story, brick veneer building with a side-gabled roof. It is essentially rectangular in plan and is built atop a concrete slab. The front façade has two small brick vestibules with gabled roofs. Fenestration for these buildings consists of paired, double-hung, wood sash windows.

Building No. 2307 is similar in elevation and construction to Buildings No. 2308 and 2310.

**Alterations/Additions**

There have been no alterations or additions made to Building No. 2307.

**Function**

Building No. 2307 has always served as uniform issuance center.

**Significance**


Building No. 2307 at Plattsburgh AFB was designed to accommodate a variety of uses and functions as needed in support of the Strategic Air Command Cold War mission. Toward that end, it proved to be an adaptable building type. This building served as the prototype for two other buildings on the base. Building 2308 – the Central Post Office, provided central post office space and bank branch space. Building 2310 – Central Post Office, provided central post office space and exchange service outlet space.


