**Significance:** The Base Supplies and Equipment Warehouse provided warehouse space for bulk and bin storage of materials with maximum protection from the weather. It was used to store supplies and equipment necessary to support base operations exclusive of explosives and ammunition.

**Project Information:** Building No. 2564 at Plattsburgh Air Force Base (AFB) is being documented in accordance with HAER standards to mitigate for the potential adverse effects of transferring deed of title to the property from federal ownership. The property transfer is a result of the disposal and reuse of Plattsburgh AFB, pursuant to the Defense Base Closure and Realignment Act of 1993. The mitigation is a stipulation of a Programmatic Agreement (PA) among the U.S. Air Force, the New York State Historic Preservation Officer, and the Advisory Council on Historic Preservation (October 2000).

**Summary Description of Base Supplies and Equipment Warehouse (Building No. 2564)**

**Layout**

Building No. 2564 is a one-story, concrete block building with a side-gabled roof. The building is rectangular in plan, measuring 62'-8" x 20'-0"; it was built atop a concrete slab. The east elevation has a personnel door nearly centered on the façade; to its right and left are larger doorways into the storage areas.

**Alterations/Additions**

Building No. 2564 experienced no major alterations or additions.

**Function**

Building No. 2564 always served as a storage facility.

**Significance**


Building No. 2564 provided the essential shelter from the elements for equipment and supplies critical to the Plattsburgh AFB mission.


