Lewiston-Queenston Bridge spanning Niagara Gorge between Lewiston, New York, (right) and Queenston, Ontario, Canada, (left), looking north-northwest from the U. S. side. The 1,600 ft.-long (1,000 ft. main span) open-spandrel, steel, deck-arch bridge opened in 1962, and it is the northernmost crossing of the Niagara River. Note the Robert Moses Hydro-electric Station at lower right and the Sir Adam Beck Hydro-electric Station at left. Both plants take in water from above Niagara Falls.
