SIGNIFICANCE (ARCHITECTURAL AND HISTORICAL, INCLUDE ORIGINAL USE OF STRUCTURE) Andrew Pinkham, originally captain of a whaling ship from Nantucket, Massachusetts, moved to Ohio in 1814 and established a farm on this site. The main house remains from Pinkham's original farm, and outbuildings have been added over the years.
