MATERIAL OF CONSTRUCTION (INCLUDE STRUCTURAL SYSTEMS) Brick wall construction. Foundation- coursed rubble stone.		
SHAPE AND DIMENSIONS OF STRUCTURE (SKETCHED FLOOR PLANS ON SEPARATE PAGES ARE ACCEPTABLE) Rectangular in shape, 40' x 61'.		
EXTERIOR FEATURES OF NOTE 2 1/2 stories plus basement with three front bays and irregular side bays. The top floor consists of Mansard roof with dormers. Brick corbelled freize beneath plain wood cornice. Facade windows adorned with shaped incised lintels and bracketed lugsills.

MAJOR ALTERATIONS AND ADDITIONS WITH DATES Porch and gabled entrance removed.
