Brief Statement  
of Significance: Said to have been built in 1868, this house  
is of the Italian Villa style.

This is perhaps the best example of the Italian Villa Style  
seen in Ohio. When photographed in 1952, it was used as an  
antique shop and residence by two maiden ladies named Warner, one  
of whom told me that her father built it in 1868 from plans, now  
lost, prepared by an architect of Columbus, Ohio, now forgotten.

It is now the Norton Funeral Home.
